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School: Central Valley Christian School
Grade Level: First

Theme/Lesson: Creation

Your objectives in this lesson:

a.) Students will understand the word “create” means to make something out of nothing.

b.) Learn that God “created” the world.

Materials needed:

- a. Playdoh
- b. Construction paper strips with seven white squares glued to the strips.

Idea:

1. Pass out play doh and have students “create” something.
2. Share our “creations” with each other.
3. Now put the play doh away and have the students try to “create” something.
4. Explain that God created by just speaking. (out of nothing).
5. After learning what God made on the seven days of creation, we make a picture timeline. Take long strips of construction paper with seven white boxes on them. Each box gets labeled by day and a picture is drawn depicting what God created on that day. The seventh box we write “God Rested”.
6. We learn the song “God Did It” (Songs from Half-Pint Hill)

The best resources to go along with the first grade Bible curriculum are the Beginner Bible videos and books. They closely follow the Bible and are at an appropriate level for first grade learners.
