Theme/Lesson: Creation/ Day 7

Your objectives in this lesson:

- a.) God rested and enjoyed His good creation on the seventh day
- b.) God established a pattern of work and rest for the world

Materials needed: The Bible ☺ and I usually use that activity sheet that is provided, as well as a bulletin board that is hanging in my room that has each numbered day along with a picture of what was created on that particular day.

Idea: For this lesson, I begin with a review of the past days we have learned thus far. I use my Creation bulletin board to help illustrate to the students what was made. Then I tell the story of Creation Day Seven. We spend time discussing what the scripture means, and then I bring it down to their level. We discuss how hard it is to just draw a beautiful picture of creation, and we connect that with how amazing God is that He actually created it. We also discuss the importance on the seventh day.

Bible Memory verse ideas- share your best strategies and tips

Idea #2: We have a memory verse that compliments our lesson. What I usually do with the memory verse is I go through the verse line by line and just talk about what it means, and what it is saying. Then, as a class we will attach motions to each word or line. We will review this memory verse a few times each day.
