

Enduring Understandings within Christian High Online

- Students in Christian High Online courses will understand that knowledge is neither independent of faith nor faith independent of knowledge. Therefore, they will understand that...
- In the beginning God created all things, and they were good. The world is God's kingdom; there is nothing in the world that is outside of God's control.
- God created humans in His image as whole persons – spiritual, physical, social, emotional, and intellectual; this relationship is intrinsic to being made in God's image. We have the responsibility to develop all areas of our lives.
- God reveals himself to us in this discipline and topic, and through this discipline we come to know God, ourselves, and the world God has created.
- Because humans disobeyed God, all of creation is affected by sin. This brokenness is reflected in all of life, including this discipline and topic.
- God has redeemed all of creation through Christ's death and resurrection; it will be fully restored when Christ comes again to rule forever.
- Knowledge and applications in this discipline or topic can be used inappropriately or for selfish intents.
- Redemption is God's gift to us. We can't truly be good or please God without God's help. As followers of Christ and out of thankfulness for His gift of salvation, it is our responsibility to demonstrate our love through love and respect for all of His creation.
- We take part in the work of the Holy Spirit and assist in the process of renewal when we share the Good News as we collaborate to make the world a better place.
- The choices we make affect community and bring about God's kingdom. As members of the Christian community, we can participate in that community, showing mercy, promoting justice, acting in godly ways and caring for God's world, or we can dishonor God, disrupt our community, and misuse God's world.
- God works through creation and the events of this world to accomplish his purposes and bring about His kingdom.
