Theme/Lesson: Jesus Washes the Disciples Feet

Objectives:

- a. Children will see the love Jesus had for his disciples.
- b. Children will understand servanthood and discuss ways to serve others.

Materials needed:

- a. Flannelgraph of story
- b. Paint and paper
- c. Basin, soap, water and towel
- d. Camera

Idea:

The story of Jesus Washing His Disciples Feet is told using flannelgraph materials as a visual. After the story, the teacher elicits responses from the children on ways to serve others, at school, at home, etc.

Teacher paints each child's feet to make their footprints and then washes their feet. She explains that this is a special way she can help and serve her students. Their footprints are a reminder of the lesson also. Pictures are taken and added to the children's year end journals as another reminder of this lesson and activity.
