Joseph in Egypt

Bible Reference: Genesis 37:36; 39-50

Lesson Objective:

To present the story of Joseph in Egypt when he revealed himself to his brothers and father.

Behavioral Objective:

Children will know that God can use bad things for the good of those who live for him.

Procedures:

Review the story of Joseph's coat using the flannel board pieces.

Ask if God was still with Joseph.

Tell how Joseph became a ruler in Egypt and how he stored food for the upcoming famine (children help fill a container with "grain" – popcorn.

Using flannel pieces, describe how the brothers came to Egypt for food.

Tell how Joseph revealed himself to them and asked that they bring his dad back with them on their next trip.

Act out the story.
