Target Audience

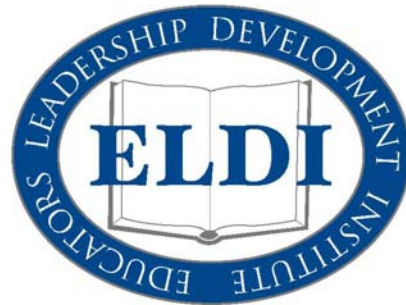
ELDI targets teachers in Christian schools who have demonstrated leadership gifts and abilities, and who are interested in exploring a future in Christian school administration.

Format

Students learn through interactive sessions using panel discussions, lecture presentations, and small group interaction. Related daily readings from current and classic education authors provide background and perspective. Students eat together, study together, and live together at the Institute venue (Geneva Park YMCA, Orillia, ON) in order to increase learning and cohesiveness.

Instructors

Jim DeKorne from CSI and Bruce Hekman from Calvin College coordinate the program along with Hugo Marcus and Ray Hendriks from OACS. Successful administrators from Christian schools in the region provide their own personal stories and expertise. Professors and other educational professionals also participate.

Funding

CSI, through its donor base, underwrites the majority of the cost. Participants pay a USD\$150 fee, but all other food, lodging, and tuition costs, plus an allowance for travel, are contributed through CSI.
