Theme/Lesson: Introduction to Bible Memory

Your objectives in this lesson:

- a.) Students will begin to understand why we memorize Scripture.

- b.) Students will create a Bible Memory Verse book to keep verse learned throughout the year. They can also use this book for daily review.

Materials needed:

Composition notebooks

Idea:

Teacher explains Psalm 119:105 to students. Teacher makes room dark and struggles to move about. Teacher uses a flashlight and discusses how the flashlight helped.

Ask students to make comparisons between the flashlight and God's word. Discuss how you may not always have a flashlight, but you can have the word of God hidden in your heart.

Students create memory verse books. Students put verse in book as new verses are created. The students use the books to work on hiding God's Word in their heart during spare time.

Students then decorate book covers and put their first memory verse inside.
*** We practice the verse daily as a class by reading, singing, acting it out, and saying it in different voices (old lady, cowboy, cheerleader, etc.)
