Christian Home & School is published by Christian Schools International for parents who send their children to Christian schools. The magazine aims to promote Christian education and to address a wide range of parenting topics. The magazine is published two times during the school year and has a circulation of 66,000 (75% U.S.; 25% Canada).

We are interested in articles that deal with timely issues that affect Christian parents. We are interested in articles about Christian schooling and the relationship of parents to Christian schools. Possible topics or subject ideas include the media and children, standardized tests, learning standards, learning difficulties, gifted and talented help, tutoring, homework help, math or reading tips, healthy kids, travel and fun, college prep, etc. (we don't publish poetry or fillers). Please see our editorial calendar for what topics we will be covering in our upcoming issue.

Articles should reflect a mature, biblical perspective. Use an informal, easy-to-read style rather than a philosophical, academic tone. Try to incorporate vivid imagery and concrete, practical examples from real life. Use multiple sources—primary sources where possible. You may wish to suggest a sidebar that contains further information or resources related to your subject.

A query is not necessary. Manuscripts can range from 1,000 to 2,000 words and should be typed (double spaced). Include your name and address at the top of the first page; also include a sentence or two about yourself for us to use as a contributor's note.
